2022 Balance of State Continuum of Care Funding Appeals Process

- Applicants will receive a summary of the priority ranking on Sept. 19th, 2022.
- Applicants that wish to appeal the ranking committee's decision must notify the Department of Housing and Community Development's CoC Program Manager (Ara Mendoza, <u>ara.mendoza@dhcd.virginia.gov</u>)in writing via email no later than close of business Sept. 22nd, 2022 with the following information
 - Agency name and contact information
 - Project name
 - Specific reason for appeal
- Applicant should note a clear explanation of the grievance with the grant application or decision-making process in their appeal.
- The Ranking Committee will review all appeals and make final decisions on Sept. 26th, 2022 via email vote.
- Applicants will be notified in writing of the appeal outcome not later than Sept. 27th, 2022.
