Effective 8/05/2011

The Department of Labor (DOL) has issued revised residential wage rates for certain work classifications in some Virginia counties. Work classes affected by these changes are Carpenter and Plumber. Please note that Wage Determinations have not changed for all localities, but in some counties, the changes are significant.

<u>Wage Determinations for Weatherization Worker, Weatherization Worker Doors & Windows</u> <u>Replacement, HVAC, and Electrician have **NOT** changed for any locality.</u>

In accordance with the applicable revisions, the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) has updated their Davis-Bacon Act Wage Determinations for ARRAfunded Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) projects. The new Wage Determinations are effective as of **August 5, 2011** and are included in Attachment 10A.

Attachment 10A shows the updated Wage Determinations for Carpenter and Plumber as well as Wage Determinations for other work classifications that have not changed from the DOL Weatherization Survey Wage Determination with the heading **S2009-VA-001**.
